WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands Prorogued until Monday, the Fifteenth day of February, instant:

I have thought fit, by and with the advice of Her Majesty's Executive Council, further to prorogue the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued until Wednesday, the Sixteenth day of March next, then to meet for the DISPATCH OF BUSINESS, of which all persons concerned are required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of this Island, at Charlottetown, in the said Island, this Ninth day of February, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and in the twenty-seventh year of Her Majesty's reign.
