the section this Sunday said no further action would be taken. The city could not pay for a private sewer on a lane off Brock street. It would be setting a precedent for numerous other cases in the city. Ald. Spence said that the Court of Revision was not a just one. He maintained that Mrs Hazelton was only entitled to pay for the frontage of her property on Brock street, and not to pay for the sewer she put in herself. Ald. Spence didn't care what the city solicitors said. He was sure if the decision was carried to a higher court Mrs Hazelton would not have to pay.

Ald. Minshall said the city sewers carried the outlet from the private sewers and was entitled to recompense.

Ald. Quinlan suggested that it be referred to the city solicitor again, but Ald. Spence objected stating that private enquiries or objections generally got filed and it was hard to secure satisfaction in this way. People were entitled to better treatment, especially when it was a matter of business.

Ald. Suddaby said he would at once take the matter up. He didn't want a cent from Mrs. Hazelton unless the city were entitled to it.

Ald. Ryerson said the city should pay for the private sewer, otherwise not collect frontage.

Ald. Spence also wanted to know when the city was to get the pavement holes fixed up. He understood that last year the paving companies came along when the snow started to fall and did some patch work. He advised that the matter be placed with the city solicitor to force the bonds.
