Ottawa, Jan. 22.—Since my last letter to the West there has been a change in the political situation and everybody is on the tip-toe of expectancy as to what the outcome will be. A hint has come from an authoritative source that the forthcoming decision of the judicial committee of the Imperial Privy Council will reverse the finding of the Supreme court of Canada rendered February 20, 1935, upon a case referred by the Governor-in-Council to that court regarding the Manitoba school question.

The appointment of Dr. G. M. Dawson, C. M. G., F. R. S., as director of the Geological Survey of Canada, has given the greatest possible satisfaction to the people of Ontario, as it must certainly have done to British Columbians. He has long been regarded as the foremost geologist in Canada.
