of a bill granting the power to raise the debt and contract this long talked of public work. My McDougall introduced another series, having as an object the primary steps towards incorporating the vast domain North and Northwest of us, as a part of Canada. The resolution proposed to state the benefit arising from this addition to our territory; and the expediency of asking the Imperial Government for the transfer of these lands to us, at the same time respecting the rights of individuals and companies. As these resolutions will come up again we reserve any further remarks for the present. We must enter our protest against the amendment to the bill of the public works since Parliament assembled, some three weeks have been spent and the closest watch is now unable to point to the results of more than one week's work.
