Sweet Alyssum, a great favorite with all lovers of plants for its sweet scented flowers, which it produces in great profusion, is very easily managed in the house. It may be had in bloom all winter, or all the year for that matter, by simply sowing a little seed at intervals of about three weeks. Prepare as many four inch pots filled with soil as may be deemed necessary for one sowing, scatter on the seeds thinly and cover lightly. Water as often as the soil becomes dry. Set the pots as close to the light as possible after the seeds begin to germinate. Repeat the operation every three weeks.
