Paris, July 3.-A meeting of Anarchists to-day adopted a resolution to blow up the Mont Blon and rescue Ravachol.

The Cholera Spreading.

St. Petersburg, July 3.-The cholera is spreading in Tiflis, Petrovsk and Astrakhan despite the stringent regulations to prevent it.

Paris to Have One.

Paris, July 3.-At a meeting of the Cabinet a project for holding an international exhibition in Paris in 1900 was approved.

The London Money Market.

London, July 3.-After the expected hardening of rates at the beginning of the week discount again related to the old rates, 2 for three months and 1 for short.

Another Battle in Tonquin.

Paris, July 3.-A dispatch from Tonquin states that another battle has occurred between the French and a large body of Tonquinese pirates, who were entrenched at Thanhoa.

The Plot Against Ferdinand.

Sofia, July 3.-The court martial proceedings against the sixteen prisoners accused of being concerned in the assassination of Prince Ferdinand, the ruler of Bulgaria, was continued yesterday.

Grand Duke Vladimir Injured.

St. Petersburg, July 3.-When the Grand Duke Vladimir, who is making a military tour of inspection in Novgorod, arrived at Tcheropet yesterday, the door of the saloon carriage in which he was riding being open, and the Grand Duke, who was leaning against it, fell heavily upon the flagstones of the station platform.

Letters from Emin Pasha.

Berlin, July 3.-The relatives of Emin Pasha in Nisene, Siliana, have received letters from the African traveler, the dates ranging from March to December, 1891, filling 36 pages in his very small handwriting.

War With Russia.

Berlin, July 3.-The Kreuz Zeitung prints an extract from the St. Petersburg Novoe Vremya, which reads: "There can be no doubt that the English influence on the German Anglophiles and Poles in the Baltic Provinces is being used by the Hebrew bankers and other influential members of that sect to force Germany into a war with Russia. So long as the German Government was not able to force the hand of the German Government, but it is evident how much this influence has gained ground since the Prince of Bismarck, is compelled to raise his warning voice to point out to his country the danger in which it stands."

The Kreuz Zeitung remarks: "Nothing could show more clearly than the foregoing quotation the injury that Prince Bismarck's utterances have inflicted on the German foreign policy."

Object to the New Taxes.

Madrid, July 3.-The new taxes imposed by the Government on various branches of business are meeting with strong opposition. A popular demonstration has been made against the new tax placed upon retail dealers. The men and women doing business there have formed a procession and marched through the streets shouting and yelling, and in every way showing their disapproval of the new tax. They assaulted the police using insulting epithets towards the civil governor. Finally the civil guard charged upon the mob, but met with an unexpected resistance. Stones, heavy sticks and anything that came handy were severely thrown at the men and women who were being driven off. The officer in command eventually gave orders to his men to fire, and a volley was poured into the rioters. This ended the fighting. It is thought that some of the injured will die.

Relics of Lord Byron.

London, July 3.-At the recent sale of the collection of the late Henry Cook a number of very interesting relics of Lord Byron were sold and brought good prices.

A brace of pocket pistols inscribed with "G. G. B. 1788," a small silver inkstand, a circular handkerchief, in gift frame, 22 all these were marked "B" with a small ivory cup, inscribed "To Mr. Donoghue, George Gordon Byron, 1788," £10 10s, a circular snuffbox, inscribed "John Wingfield to G. G. B. Byron, 1803," £6 8s; a curious pipe, formerly Napoleon Bonaparte's and marked with the imperial crown and "N." £13 1s; a small
