that the situation in that district was very serious owing to the struggle between Catholics and Baptists. On the night of the earthquake he and his companions, he said, were brutally attacked. "The police officials," said Mr. Stuart, "wanted us to leave the province immediately and secretly, but this we refused to do, as the Italians would have said that we had fled, and we would have lost all that we had already accomplished. Later, however, we took our departure according to arrangements, in a public manner, but we were guarded against the 1,000 or more persons who lined the streets, yelling, cursing and threatening us."

Premier Luzzatti urged upon Mr. Stuart the advisability of avoiding any revolutionary measures or any demonstration, which would be apt to disturb the peace. He expressed the opinion that the action of the Italians was due to their panic-stricken condition, because of the earthquake, than to any enmity against the Americans.

Mr. Stuart has decided to postpone his return to the district in order to allow the excitement to subside.
