

and consular missions. The Office of Protocol of the Department of External Affairs is ready at all times to discuss the level of protective security required.

In case of emergency the diplomatic or consular mission may notify the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at (613) 952-4200 at all hours.

11. Firearms

Diplomatic and consular personnel are expected to comply fully with Canadian laws and regulations governing the registration, possession, and carriage of firearms of any kind.

12. Telecommunications

12.1 Wireless Radio Transmitters

The diplomatic mission must apply for a licence to install and to operate a wireless radio transmitter on its premises. The granting of such a licence is discretionary, and is based on reciprocity and on conformity with the Radio Act (Canada) and corresponding regulations.

12.2. Mobile/Cellular Telephones and Mobile Radio Stations

The diplomatic or consular mission must request an authorization to instal and to operate mobile/cellular telephones and mobile radio stations on its premises, in its cars, or in the residences of diplomatic or consular personnel.
