ARTICLE X

The Government of the Gabonese Republic shall grant Canadian firms and Canadian personnel freedom from currency exchange restrictions in respect of:

- (a) the exportation of remunerations, salaries and other earnings paid by the Government of the Gabonese Republic in CFA francs in respect of a project;
- (b) the re-exportation of salaries or remunerations transferred from abroad through authorized banking institutions in Gabon.

ARTICLE XI

The Government of the Gabonese Republic shall inform Canadian firms and Canadian personnel of local acts and regulations which may concern them in the performance of their duties.

ARTICLE XII

The Government of the Gabonese Republic shall facilitate the repatriation of Canadian personnel and their dependants in cases where, in the opinion of the Government of CANADA or of the Government of the Gabonese Republic, the lives or safety of the Canadian personnel and/or their dependants are endangered.

ARTICLE XIII

- 1. The Government of the Gabonese Republic agrees to extend to their Canadian personnel and to their dependants the privileges and exemptions referred to in Article VI to XIII and Annex "B" to firms and to non-governmental institutions and organizations engaged in the execution of development assistance projects pursuant to any arrangement between the Government of the Gabonese Republic and the firm or non-governmental institution or organization.
- 2. A non-governmental institution or organization means a non-governmental institution or organization that receives a contribution from the Government of Canada for a project pursuant to a contribution arrangement between the Government of Canada and the non-governmental institution or organization.
