Agreements concluded:

1. Canada-Netherlands: Financial Agreement (with Exchange of Notes) supplementing the Financial Agreement signed between the two countries at Ottawa on February 5, 1946. Signed at Ottawa, January 29, 1947. (See February 1946 Bulletin, Section A(3))
2. Canada-United Kingdom: Exchange of Notes concerning the Grant to Airlines of Traffic Rights in Fiji and Canton Island. Signed at London January 31 and February 1, 1947.
3. Multilateral: Treaty of Peace with Italy. Signed at Paris on February 10, 1947. (See Section G(a)31(b))
4. Multilateral: Treaty of Peace with Hungary. Signed at Paris on February 10, 1947. (See Section G(a)31(b))
