On Wednesday, which is a short day, I would like very much if the house would consider item No. 2 on today's order paper, the Freight Rates Reduction Act which we almost finished with before the Christmas adjournment. paper, which we almost reached just before Christmas, the C.N.R. capital expenditures. The Prime Minister suggested today that on Thursday and Friday we would deal with the estimates of the Department of External Affairs.
