

" Rule 54 Deleted and the following inserted:
 " Any person seeking to obtain any Private Bill
 " giving any exclusive privilege or profit, or
 " private or corporate advantage, or for any
 " amendment of any former Act, shall be
 " required to deposit with the Clerk of the Senate
 " eight days before the meeting of the House
 " a copy of such Bill in the English or French
 " language, with a sum sufficient to pay
 " for translating and printing the same -
 " 600 copies to be printed in English and 200 copies
 " to be printed in French - the translation to be
 " done by the officers of the House and the
 " printing by the Contractor. The applicant
 " shall also be required to pay the Clerk of the
 " Senate a sum of \$ 200, and the cost of
 " ^{the same} printing for the Statutes, and lodge the receipts
 " for the same with the Clerk of the Committee
 " to which such Bill is referred - such payments
 " to be made immediately after the second
 " reading, and before the consideration of
 " the Bill by such Committee "
