My dear Lionel,

I am giving some Lowell Lectures at Boston next March on the British Anti-Slavery Movement from 1770 to the present day.

I have accepted an invitation from President Cody of Toronto University to give two lectures there, and am planning to return via Montreal and Halifax.

I should like to lecture at McGill (if I were wanted!) I met Currie in your company, but of course I can't write and propose myself. But perhaps you would write? I could talk about India (with inside and up-to-date knowledge from the I.O.) or Dominion Status or the Irish Controversy (probably undesirable) or general ideas about the modern British Empire.

It is impossible to fix an exact date till the sailings are published, but I expect to be at Toronto about April 10 and so at Montreal about April 13 or Good Friday.
