One more point I might mention; sometimes parents hesitate a .

little in seming boys out here from the other side, owing to the fact that
we have no residence arrangement. I do not think, however, that there has
been any case in which English boys have not been able to look after themselves
satisfactorily. A good many of them join fratermities, and we are always
glad to interest curselves in giving them a little more attention then the
young men whose parents are near at hand.
