

The Masians from the south stopped opposite the Ands, then turned south ^{and east} alongside the Mans in the Hindu or Par district. In Egyptian west is emnt (Armanat, Teutonic Man or Amans), north is mecht (Teutonic Males or Mecklings), east is yecht (A kts) and ebteh (Bets, Abats) and south res (Russ), gemat (Kams) and khebih (Cofts). The words may be from different places ⁱⁿ ^{Sydia} always further south-east. Mats or Madas from Thessaly came in near Adramyttium (Adrav-Mut, Davidian Mats). The Davidian name came in later here. The Mats spread southward west of the Germanic people. They were alongside (or mitz) around the Letts and some Slavs near there were Adraavs mostly called Etrui (Slavic Otrou or ltrou). These had left near the Pars before. Letts, Adraavs, and latinized Pans developed here into a tribe, the Spans. They all have otri, otros, others and adhrir for "the others".

From the eastern end of the Lithuanian district the Daus had a solid line southward below the higher country. When Immigrants came in from Rontus, the Duses stayed a while in Mysia and then came over to the higher country east of the Daus. When the Slavs saw that, they got jealous, and the Russians went over and drove the Duses west into the Dau streak and the former Russian district, and took possession of the claims of the Duses.

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
