Appendix. 2. More particularly therefore the function of the Forest Products Laboratories is research and technical service in connection with: -(a) Every article in the manufacture of which timber is directly utilized, e.g. railway ties, furniture. Derived products, e.g. pulp and paper, artificial (b) silk, alcohols, acetic acid. (c) Minor products, e.g. turpentine, essential oils, resins. (d) Utilization of byeproducts or wastes now worthless, many of which are of potential or possible commercial value, such as waste sulphite liquor (containing over 40% of the original wood material), sawdust and other wood wastes, barks.
