### FAIRLY STEADY TRADE AT UNION STOCK YARDS

There Was Little or No Change  
in Values in Butchers' Cattle  
Yesterday.

### DEMAND FOR YEARLINGS Forward Springers Would Have Found Ready Sale at Firm Prices.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards on Wednesday were 113 cars, comprising 1273 cattle, 2609 horses, 180 sheep, 44 calves, 23 horses.

Butchers' Cattle.—Notwithstanding the unexpected liberal supply of butchers' cattle yesterday, over 1300, there was a fairly steady trade, with little or no change in values. The top price for a carload was \$7.50, and there were three single cattle reported as being sold over \$8 per cwt., but the extra quality brought the extra money. There was a lot of medium cattle that sold around \$7 and \$7.25 per cwt.; in fact the bulk of the cattle on sale were common and medium, little better than half-finished. The cow and bull prices remained firm at steady values.
