A NEW METHOD IN HANDLING CONTRACTS FOR WAR MUNITIONS

Ottawa, Nov. 1.—The diplomatic statement of D. A. Thomas, representative of Lloyd George, given to the press before his departure yesterday, brings to-day no attempt at refutation or criticism upon the part of any member of the government, the militia department or the now practically defunct Canadian Shell Committee.

Mr. Thomas' statement that "the profits of the manufacturers have been higher than they were entitled to," a statement which when delivered in his Montreal speech provoked a sharp retort from General Sir Sam Hughes, is now unchallenged and must be accepted as a fact. These profits will in the future not be so high as they have been in the past. A "fair" profit is to be given, but there are to be no more millionaires made at the expense of the British taxpayer, if Lloyd George can help it.

The reorganization of the shell committee under the direction of Lionel Hitchens, former head of the Canadian Laid Company, with the retirement of the manufacturing members of the old shell committee, means that Col. Cantley, head of the Nova Scotia Steel Company, Mr. Watts, of the Canada Foundry Company, of Toronto, and possibly some others will be retired.

The new committee is to be under the direct authority and control of the imperial minister of munitions. Formerly there has been some doubt as to whether the committee was an imperial or a Canadian body. The prime minister has now decided that it shall be controlled by the imperial authorities. In this connection it is probable that auditors who may be appointed will have to be approved by the imperial authorities.

The committee, it would also appear, will now be immune from enquiry or investigation at the hands of the Canadian parliament.

Contracts will be made direct on behalf of the British minister of munitions with the Canadian manufacturers and a competitive system of tendering will replace the comparatively haphazard and costly method formerly employed. Hitherto there has been no policy of competitive bidding among manufacturers to bring prices to a basis fair to the British taxpayer and the British treasury.

Sub-contracting and middlemen will under the new system, be done away with. In this connection certain firms which were not properly equipped for the work of making munitions, but which in the past secured contracts on the principle of "relieving industrial depression," will have to show that they can make deliveries in the time specified, and at the prices accepted as reasonable before they can secure a slice of the business.
