


HOW THE BALKANS BLOCK TURKEY



Charles S. Whitman, governor-elect of New York. He was much in the limelight as the result of the Rosenbach murder and the trial of the famous 'gun-men'.



By an unfortunate chain of circumstances, the Imperial Theatre this afternoon was without its usual singing and vaudeville attractions.


