SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS

Entry by proxy may be made at any dominion lands agency (but not subagency), on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least eighty acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months' residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also fifty acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fity acres and erect a house worth \$300.

The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scruby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.
