HAVE CROSSED OCEAN IN 38 FOOT LAUNCH.

Mariner and His Son Complete Voyage from New York to Falmouth.

Falmouth, Eng., Aug. 14.—Captain Norman and his son Edward arrived here tonight in the 38 foot launch Abiel Abbott Low, in which they sailed from New York July 2 in an interview with a representative of the Associated Press Captain Norman said:

"The launch has proved a noble boat, but we experienced awful times since we left New York. Several times, in terrible gales, we nearly lost our dear and aged mother, who was with us. We had great trouble with the kerosene because the tanks which held it broke and oil flooded the cabin."

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
