

## LOCAL ACTS PASSED IN 1840.

"An Act to defray certain charges that have arisen for the support of Aged and Infant Paupers up to the 1st of February, 1840."

"An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares and Merchandise imported into this Colony and its Dependencies."

"An Act to establish the Fees and Costs chargeable in the several Police Offices and Courts of Sessions in this Colony."

"An Act to Repeal an Act entitled 'An Act to vest in the Treasury the Sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Pounds granted to Her Majesty under an Act passed in the First Year of the Reign of her present Majesty, and remaining unappropriated, and to re-appropriate the same for the purpose of facilitating a Communication by Steam between the Port of Saint John's and the Port of Halifax, in the Province of Nova-Scotia, and to make further provision for facilitating Communication by Steam between the said Ports of Saint John's and Halifax."

"An Act to encourage the Whale Fishery in this Colony."

"An Act to continue an Act passed in the Fifth Session of the General Assembly of this Island, entitled 'An Act to continue the Office of Clerk of the Central Circuit Court and the Office of Clerk of the Supreme Court, and to make provision for the Officer discharging the duties of the said Offices."

"An Act to defray certain Expenses and Outstanding Claims on the Board of Road Commissioners in Saint John's, and for other purposes."

"An Act to make further provision towards defraying the Expenses of the Civil Government of this Colony by raising certain Duties."

"An Act for granting to Her Majesty a sum of Money for defraying the expenses of the Civil Government of this Colony and for other purposes, for the Year ending 30th June, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-one."

"An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Supplies for the Civil Government of this Colony and other purposes."
