measure of safety and convenience.

The work at this school appears to be progressing in a very satisfactory way. The Rev. Father Portier is in charge as Principal. He appears to be a good business man, and is taking a keen interest in the welfare of the school. He is assisted by Mr. Balduc as Farmer, and Mr. Chartier as engineer. The interior work is performed by thirteen Sisters including the Superior. Rev. Sister St. Ferdinand, who has had many years experience in managing Indian schools.
