teenth section of the said lastly in part recited Act, and by order in Council to issue a Proclamation dissolving the union between the said County of Bruce and the said County of Huron, from the date to be mentioned in such Proclamation: and all the provisions of the said lastly in part recited Act, or of any other Act, or law of Upper Canada, applicable to Counties, on and 5 after their being separated from other counties, shall apply to the said Counties of Huron and Bruce respectively.

First meeting of Council.

III. The said Provisional Council shall meet at in the said County ; a notice of such meeting shall be published in some newspaper published within the said county, or in some adjoining 10 county, and a copy of such notice sent by mail or otherwise to each mem. ber of such Provisional Council, at least eight days before the day appointed for such meeting, by the Warden of the said United Counties of Huron and Bruce, or if such meeting should fail on the said day, a meeting may be called in like manner for another day. 15

Who shall meeting.

IV. The said Warden of the United Counties of Huron and Bruce, shall preside at first by a warrant under his hand and seal, appoint one of the Town Reeves or Deputy Town Reeves of the said county of Bruce to preside at the first meeting of such Provisional Municipal Council until a Provisional Warden shall be elected by such Provisional Municipal Council.

V. This Act shall be deemed to be a public Act. Public Act.
