Camp Borden, Ontario.	13-4-42	cont'd	Assistant Section Officer H.G. Sparrow (V30066) R.C.A.F. (W.D.) and W300867 Sgt. Ball, K.I. R.C.A.F. (W.D.) reported for duty.  Yale 3371 ground looped on main aerodrome Camp Borden at 1730 hours. The Pilot, R130584 LAC Abbott, C.R., who was practising steep turns and precautionary landings was uninjured. Pilot lost control while landing, due to cross wind, which caused aircraft to lean over breaking left oleo leg, damaging airscrew, port wing and engine. Crash categorized C2.  Harvard 3167 ground looped on main aerodrome Camp Borden at 1500 hours. The Pilot, R113058 LAC Clark, W.A., was uninjured. Ground loop occurred while Pilot was practising solo circuits and landings. Aircraft was caught in a cross wind which caused starboard wing to drop when close to the ground. The starboard oleo leg, wing tip, aileron and flap were damaged. Categorized C1.

	15-4-42		Harvard 3073 ground looped on main aerodrome Camp Borden at 1030 hours. Pilot Officer J.B. Stirling (J9338) and R123358 LAC Andrews, W.J. both uninjured. Ground loop occurred during exercises, sequence 6, 7, 10, 17, 15, caused by Instructor failing to take control and correct drop in 90 degree cross wind. Student on coming in for landing, levelled off too high and stalled. Strong wind caused starboard wing to drop, striking runway and damaging wing tip, aileron and oleo leg. Categorized C1.
