It was proposed by Brother N Therrien, Seconded by that Brother Qualette -- xxxx a committee composed of Mr Gignac and Mr parent should have an interview with the general manager of the company, Mr A G Mole to know if the company was serious in this reduction of wages, and if so, that the mule spinners should be authorized to go on strike Monday morning, the 4th day of May, that they should not go back to their work without the understanding that the said reduction would not be enforced in any department of the Dominion Textile Company

It was also decided unanimously by the Council that the Council would take all means at its disposal to protect the mule spinners in case of a stike.
