(Mr. Griffith, p.1611) "The last thing you will find in the speeches of the Imperial Conference is economic unity. The spirit in all is economic nationalism of the strongest kind, and we have been infected by it ourselves. One after another, we say: 'They stand for Canada first, we stand for Great Britain first.' I would rather say the Empire first, indeed I would go further and say, the whole of civilisation first. Imperial trade is better than insular trade, but I think world trade is the best of all."
