

to a permanent seat. It is hoped that these amendments might in the end afford Spain sufficient justification for remaining in the League.

H.M. Government have explained their views to the German Government, who were beginning to show signs of restiveness and whose good faith has not been entirely above suspicion. The German Government have been reassured it is the prime object of H.M. Government to ensure Germany's entry into the League and that they will not support any other candidate for a permanent seat; but at the same time they have impressed on the German Government great advantage that would result were it possible to make an accommodation regarding non-permanent seats which would satisfy Spanish and Polish claims.
