I have interviewed the Department

of Marine re these coasts,  
and am assured that there is no  
disposition to press the claim, in  
fact that the department does not  
agree with the award, and that  
official action to dispose of it is  
likely to be taken.

I have also had the circum-  
stances of your case brought to  
the attention of the higher-ups

2 in the C.G.M.M., and am  
assured that a proper inquiry  
will be set on foot without  
delay.

From other sources the  
head officers have had reports  
of irregularities which lead  
them to give credence to the  
theory of a "frame-up" on  
which your petition is based ;  
and I am convinced that these  
gentlemen really desire to get  
at the truth and that pun-

3 ishment will follow the dis-  
covery of guilt. I do not  
know yet whether or not  
I may have an opportunity  
of meeting the investigating  
officer, but I will try to bring  
this about.
