I have to acquaint you that the Superintendent General has been informed that the original posts no longer exist which marked the outer boundary of the Indian Reserve containing sixteen hundred acres, partly in Bigby, and partly in Winnipeg counties, Manitoba, and that it is apprehended by the Indians owning the Reserve that white people are encroaching.
