It was thought that an arrangement could have been made without difficulty with Mr. Scarth for the exchange referred to, but it will be observed from Mr. Dundas's letter that Mr. Scarth does not consider the land in Pa-pot's Reserve at Indian Head equal to that appropriated from the land owned by the North West Land Co. for a Reserve for that Chief, and Mr. Scarth would prefer to exchange his land for the same number of even numbered sections in Townships 19, 20 and 21 Ranges 18 and 19 West of the second meridian.
