
Ottawa, 7th September, 1907.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant, in regard to the seizure of hemlock logs cut without authority on the Whitefish Lake Indian Reserve and requesting the release of same.

In reply I have to state that the Department sent a man to measure the stumps and estimate the quantity of timber cut, but his report has not been received. It is expected soon and will be promptly acted on, but in the meantime, I regret to have to state that the seizure must be maintained.
