As the blocks in question are situated in unsurveyed territory the Hudson's Bay Company's claim has no force and consequently there should be no objection to granting the desired blocks of land on account of any claim of the Hudson's Bay Company.

It is hoped that your Department will see its way to grant the said two blocks of land as additions to the Lake St. Martin Indian Reserve No. 48 and to have the same confirmed by Order in Council at an early date.
