



Ottawa, 3rd March, 1915.

Sir:-

I enclose for your information copy of a letter of the 25th ultimo, which the Department has received from Mr. T.M. Richards of Edmundston in regard to an account for relief supplies furnished Indians. You will observe there is still \$8.00 due him for goods furnished. The Department desires that you will kindly look carefully into this matter and report all the facts. If there is a further amount due Mr. Richards, an account covering the same should be submitted in the usual way with a view to payment. I beg to say that cheque No. 328 which Mr. Richards mentions was sent him on the 22nd ultimo, was issued for \$44.05 and was in payment of an account for goods supplied in December, which account you forwarded under cover of your letter of the 6th February.
