In view of the report in your letter of lith instant to the effect that Indians of your Lemoy have promised their land for sowing and are decisons of receiving seed, I beg to may that you may inour an expenditure or fifty dollars in the parabase of necessary seed wheat and outs for them.

The Department will expect you to see that only those Indians who have prepared their land for seeding share in the distribution of the seed, and only such quantity of seed as is required in each case should be supplied. You should give kindly advise and encouragement to the Indians in their work.

When you send in the accounts for the send you should formed a statement showing the name of each recipient of send, which states ment should show the kind and quanty of send supplied each individual and the value of the sume.

If possible the indians should be made to save send in the fall to do their planting next year, or be required to seem the send furnished.
