Dear Sir (or Madam):

The Ottawa Kennel Club is holding the first of its Evening Shows of the Season in ST. GEORGE'S PARISH HALL, (Gloucester & Metcalfe Sts.) on Friday evening, February 5th. For this first show, Terriers (except Bostons) and Toy breeds will be judged.

It is understood that you are the owner of a dog of one of the above mentioned breeds and you are, therefore, invited to have same present on the evening specified. The judging will commence at 8.00 P.M. sharp and the show will be over at 10.00 P.M. (For this show the dogs are not benched, you merely keep them with you until the show is concluded.)

If you are a novice at exhibiting, you will have every assistance afforded you by the Committee in charge. There is no difficulty involved, and you may be pleasantly surprised. Last season we had a great number of novice exhibitors present and SOME OF THE DOGS SHOWN FOR THE FIRST TIME WERE AMONG THE BEST SPECIMENS PRESENT.

At the Final Show which will be held in April there will be numerous special prizes awarded, and these will be so arranged that every dog present will have a fair opportunity of taking home some valuable trophy. Last year there were some 87 special prizes, besides the Kennel Club Trophies.

Entry fees for non-members of the Kennel Club - 50¢ for first entry and 25¢ for each additional entry of the same dog; for members, 25¢ for first entry and 10¢ for each additional entry of the same dog.

We invite you to become a member of the Ottawa Kennel Club. A Year's Membership is one dollar and admits you to all shows free and the entry fees are reduced as above. (The Ottawa Kennel Club is the only one of its kind in the city of Ottawa.) You need not be a member to exhibit and your dog need not be pedigreed. All dogs are given a number and are judged accordingly, irrespective of owner or breeding.

Now this is a show for Ottawa District dogs EXCLUSIVELY and we earnestly invite you to be present, or if you are unable to be present yourself send your dog along and he will have the same opportunity as if you yourself were present. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE ADMITTED FREE. Remember the date - Friday, February 5th at St. George's Parish Hall, Gloucester & Metcalfe Sts. Give your dog a little brushing up and bring or send him along and give him the opportunity he has been waiting for.

In order that judging may start at 8.00 P.M. sharp, entries will be taken from 7.00 P.M. to 8.00 P.M., so please be on hand early and we feel sure you will have a very enjoyable evening. The judges will be:-
