Also three fuselages which were hoping to rebuild at sometime these were

- Piper J3 - CF - BRT ✓
- Piper J3 - CF - DLJ ✓
- Piper J3 - CF - ~~EGN~~ EGN ✓

There was not any of our airplanes saved at all everything went in the fire, plus all our records, which also included the log books for these aircraft. Hoping that this is satisfactory.
