*Resolved*,—That a Drawback of the amount of Duty paid be given on the following articles used in the construction of Ships built in this Colony, of Fifty Tons and upwards, viz., Chains, Anchors, Iron Nails, Copper, Muntz Metal, Canvass and Cordage : Provided that satisfactory proof be given that the Articles have been so used before the said amount of Drawback is paid. Amendment on Motion that Report be adopted.

And the question being put thereon, the House divided, when there appeared—
