A statue of Martin Luther was unveiled at Newmarket, Germany, Tuesday. Prince Frederick Leopold represented the Emperor, and made a speech.

Two unknown men succeeded on Monday in mutilating a portrait of Mr. Gladstone on exhibition in London, and escaping without arrest.

S. W. McMichael, Finance Inspector of Customs at Toronto, has been promoted to the office of Chief Inspector of Customs.

An explosion of five damp occurred in a mining pit near Antonienhutte, Prussian Silesia, while five hundred men were at work in the mine. Only 40 were rescued.

A statement made in the House by Mr. Boyd referring to Mr. Martin was characterized as false by a member for Winnipeg, but, under the threat of the speaker to name him, he withdrew the word.

The Champlain monument cost \$40,000. It will be erected on a site granted by the Government of Quebec in Quebec City. Lieut-Governor Chapleau is a subscriber to the amount of \$2,000.

The danger which threatens the sheep export trade, owing to the trans-shipment of diseased animals through Canada was brought before Parliament yesterday.

John Casey, an old and prominent resident of Madoc Township, and the Conservative nominee for North Hastings, died Tuesday from apoplexy. He had been treasurer of the township for the last three years.

Fines of \$50 and costs were imposed on each member of the American crew caught dumping garbage in the river near Amherstburg. In default of payment they were sent to gaol at Sandwich for two weeks.

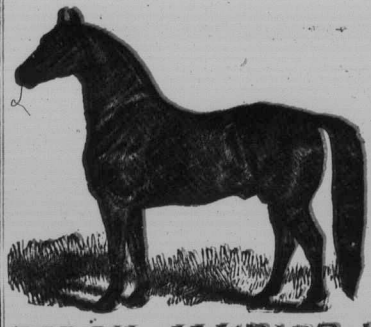

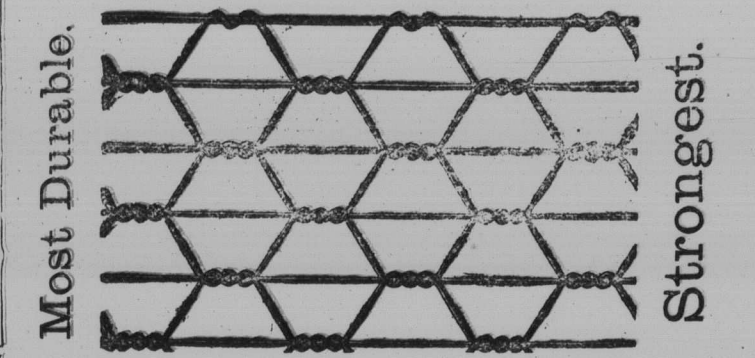
