AN INTERESTING DECISION.—A suit was decided at the recent London Assizes, which is of considerable interest. The plaintiff was a farmer. In January last he effected an insurance with the Reliance Mutual Fire Insurance Company, for \$600, receiving an interim receipt for the first payment. The proporty was burned down before the policy was received by the plaintiff, and the Company denied that they were liable for the \$600, on the ground that the claim was not valid unless the policy was actually held by the plaintiff at the time of the destruction of the property. Mr. Justice Burton held that the acceptance of the first payment was sufficient evidence of liability to insure the payment of the amount insured for, and accordingly instructed the jury to bring in a verdict for the full sum claimed which was done.


