"It is undisputed that a large proportion of our boys, perhaps 75 percent, of them drop out of Sunday school in their teens," said Secretary Wilson, of the Y. M. C. A. "It is quite certain that the Sunday school teachers are doing what they can, but the fact remains that the boys quit Sunday school, and many drift away from the church. We want to find the cause of this, and apply the remedy. We will make a thorough investigation."
