

We would not inconsiderately throw cold water on the enterprise of our friends in lower Canada who have spert money and effort in trying to establish heie the manufacture of beet-sugar; but we think that by this time it must be allowed that the attempt has failed. sugar beet grows well, and comes either to perfection or very near to it. But the production of the beet root, of good quality too, is not enough. inference from all this is close at hand. Raw sugar should be admitted duty free as tropical product, not competing with anything that we can produce in Canada. At the same time refined sigar should pay a duty which would give to the refining business the same protection it has now. It would be no great trick of finance at all to reduce the sugar duties from three to two cents all round, and still have the home refining business well protected. The pro-tection of home refining should be continued for the reason that we have positively had for the reason that we have positively had made better sugar, for better value on the dollar's worth under protection than we had before. But why not admit raw sugar free, leaving the duties on refined sugar in proportion as now ? The finance minister will make a popular move when he does this. Not only so, but he will knock clean off their feet lots of those free trade "argu
