

ENGLAND'S GREAT STRIKE

INAUGURATION OF THE BATTLE ON SATURDAY.

Miners in Lancashire, Yorkshire, Durham and Cheshire quit work to the number of many thousands—Belgian Shippers Sending Coal to the Tyne and to the Thames.

LONDON, March 12.—The great coalmen's strike was inaugurated in accordance with the plan of the Miners' Federation, which in its manifesto issued a few days ago declared that the holiday the men proposed to take was for the purpose of clearing the markets of the surface coal and of restricting the output in order to prevent the masters from using the low prices as an excuse for lowering wages.

At 2 o'clock in the afternoon the men employed in the mines in Lancashire, Cheshire and Yorkshire stopped work and the ponies were removed from the pits.

The only men at work now are surface men, pumpers, ventilators, attendants, etc., who the Federation have not called out.

In Durham mining work has also completely stopped. It was hoped until today that some sort of a compromise would be arrived at, but no agreement has been reached, and the strike is now a general one.

Belgian shippers are sending coal to the Tyne and the Thames, but they refuse to give any information as to the quantity they have shipped. The old collieries carrying these consignments are expected to arrive at Newcastle and other ports will attempt to prevent the discharge of these cargoes and it is feared this will lead to a renewal of the dock trouble.

Twenty thousand miners in Nottingham quit work on Saturday. When the men came out of the pits they brought their tools with them. The coal stocks in the Bristol districts are already nearly exhausted.

The miners there have also stopped work and as a result the price of coal has gone up four shillings per ton. Many manufacturers refuse to pay the price demanded and have closed their factories.

In this respect the action of the miners is working greatly to the harm of the country, and it is believed that at the conference to be held Wednesday next by the Miners' Federation, it will be decided to limit the holiday to a week and to restrict the output during the summer.

NATURAL GAS AT NEW TORONTO. A Big Flow Struck on Saturday Afternoon.

For the past two years the Government buildings at New Toronto have been burning natural gas, accidentally struck when putting down a well for water. The supply, notwithstanding the limited depth of the well subsequently sunk, having kept up steadily a company was formed to ascertain the extent of the store. Operations have been in progress for three months with the result that on Saturday afternoon, according to information received at this office, a large flow of natural gas was struck. This is the fourth and largest flow encountered.
