And now we are told that three ladies will accompany Mr. Arnot and his wife as missionaries to Caranganze, and to accomplish the journey they will have to be carried in hammocks for hundreds of miles. Women who accompanied Bishop Taylor have shown a degree of courage in venturing into the perils of Africa which promise well for their heroic enterprise.
