2.—The BARIS used in connection with two wires should not be twisted around both wires, which defeats the object of the two wires, preventing their colling together or uncolling slightly with the cold or heat.

3.—The BARIS must be short enough so that it will not necessarily tear the animal. A sharp instantaneous prick is all that is beded.

4.—The BARIS must be firmly twisted upon ONLY ONE of the two wires, the second wire thus held-it in its place.

5.—The BARIS, with reference to the main wire or wires, should not form in the slightest sense a HOOK.

G.—HARBS two in a group are more effectual than four in a group.

7.—The BARIS should be as light as possible in weight, and still be efficient, for the MATERIAL IS BOUGHT BY THE POUND.
