

PATENT FLAT WIRE LATHING

ARCHITECTS AND CONTRACTORS:
Gentlemen: I take this opportunity of bringing to your
notice my Flat Wire Lathing, for which patents have
been issued in the United States and Canada. The ob-
ject of the patent is to provide a light, yet substantial
Fire-proof Lathing, which offers a smooth, unbroken
surface for the reception of plaster, and on which the
plaster will key securely. Being made of flat wire, it
offers the best plastering surface of any wire lathing.
The key is an absolute certainty and is obtained by the
plaster turning over the edge of the wire; this will be
found invaluable in the plastering of ceilings. Its many
advantages over Round Wire Lathing are apparent.
An adjustable foot made of sheet metal, having two
hooks, is attached to the lathing and takes the place of
luring. By means of these feet the lathing can be
fixed in position at one-half the cost of lathing requiring
luring. After the cloth is woven the feet may be at-
tached in any position required. The cloth may be used
in either plain or with the adjustable foot as shown in
cut.
