Article XVIII

This Agreement shall come into force on the date of signature.

Article XIX

The two Governments agree to exchange information and technical assistance in the field of nuclear energy, including the design, construction, operation and maintenance of nuclear reactors, and the use of nuclear energy for peaceful purposes. The exchange of information and technical assistance shall be carried out through the International Atomic Energy Agency.

Recognizing the utility of the resources and services of the Agency, the two Governments agree to cooperate in the field of nuclear energy through the International Atomic Energy Agency. The exchange of information and technical assistance shall be carried out through the Agency.

Article XX

Article XXI

In the interpretation of the present Agreement, it shall be applied in accordance with the following provisions: (a) The designation of the Station shall be the Rajasthan Atomic Power Station.
