In Ottawa, missions should obtain the form "Authorization to purchase tax exempt beer" from the above office, and complete the form in duplicate, indicating the brands and quantities required, the names, positions and Ontario Sales Exemption Card numbers of the persons ordering the beer. Diplomatic and career consular officers are only entitled to exemption from provincial sales tax, upon presentation of their tax exemption card, on beer at other Brewer's Retail outlets.

2. <u>Transportation</u>

Provincial legislation on liquor and alcohol prohibits their transportation from one province to another.

B. IMMUNITIES

(a) The Vienna Conventions on Diplomatic Relations and on Consular Relations are in large measure an embodiment of current customary international law on the subject of diplomatic immunities. However, its application in Canada proceeds from the Diplomatic and Consular Privileges and Immunities Act. It is to be noted, furthermore, that the persons to whom immunities apply are divided into categories as laid down by the Vienna Conventions. Entitlement to and verification may need to be made. The Office of the Chief of Protocol, Department of External Affairs, should be consulted in any doubtful situation.

Diplomatic and Consular officers who are nationals or permanent residents of Canada shall enjoy only immunity from jurisdiction and inviolability in respect of official acts performed in the exercise of their functions.
