- Conclude further bilateral or multilateral agreements and support initiatives and cooperation, where appropriate, which include measures to facilitate the identification, tracing, freezing, seizure and forfeiture of drug crime proceeds.
- Convene a financial action task force from Summit
 Participants and other countries interested in these
 problems. Its mandate is to assess the results of
 cooperation already undertaken in order to prevent the
 utilization of the banking system and financial
 institutions for the purpose of money laundering, and to
 consider additional preventive efforts in this field,
 including the adaptation of the legal and regulatory
 systems so as to enhance multilateral judicial assistance.
 The first meeting of this task force will be called by
 France and its report will be completed by April 1990.

54) International cooperation against AIDS

We take note of the creation of an International Ethics committee on AIDS which met in Paris in May 1989, as decided at the Summit of Venice (June 1987). It assembled the Summit Participants and the other members of the EC, together with the active participation of the World Health Organization.
