If the time limits mentioned above are not observed, either Government shall be entitled, in the absence of an alternative arrangement between the two Governments on other possibilities of settling the dispute, to request the President of the International Court of Justice in The Hague to make the necessary appointment. The arbitration committee shall reach its decision by majority of votes. The decision shall be definitive and must be carried out.

In any case, it shall be necessary to obtain the prior consent of the President of the International Court of Justice and to submit the case to him in order that he may make a decision on the choice of members of the arbitration committee.

13. A technical agreement between the Egyptian Museum, Cairo and the National Museums of Canada, which will be an integral part of this Protocol will be attached to this Protocol as Annex B. It contains the technical conditions for the application of the present Protocol with regard to transportation, insurance, packing and unpacking of the exhibits loaned by the Arab Republic of Egypt as well as matters regarding the financing and general organization of the exhibition.

14. This Protocol will take effect on the date of its signature and will remain in effect until the complete fulfilment by the two parties of the terms and conditions contained herein, and the handing over of the objects of the exhibition to the authorities of the Federal Republic of Germany in the presence of representatives of the Egyptian Antiquities Organization.

Done in Cairo on the Sixth day of November 1978 in duplicate, in Arabic, English and French, all texts being equally authentic.
